### the great commission

"19 Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup> teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

### the great commandment

<sup>29</sup> Jesus answered, "The most important is, 'Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. <sup>30</sup> And you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength.' <sup>31</sup> The second is this: 'You shall love your neighbour as yourself.' There is no other commandment greater than these."

Mark 12:29-31

### the church does not have a mission, the mission has a church

~

We do not have the authority to define nor redefine the purpose of Jesus' church. The 21<sup>st</sup> century church still has a 1<sup>st</sup> century mandate. Therefore every church's mission statement should ultimately be a version of Jesus' original plan, best summarized under *The Great Commission* and *The Great Commandment*.

We have distilled these two great mandates into our mission statement, also affectionately known as our **manifesto**:



Here at City Gates we talk a lot about our manifesto. But we don't just want to **say** it, we want to **see** it. The purpose of this tool is to give our community common language around what it means to help people find & follow Jesus.

You will discover that each of the words in our manifesto also embody our core values. **They describe who we are.** Over the next few pages we will take a closer look at each, ending with an exercise to both *assess* and *assist* you in valuing the same.

You will notice that as with our manifesto, *Jesus* literally has the last word in the sentences that describe our values - which is precisely why we have to talk about Him *first*. **He truly is at the centre of who we are, what we do, and why we do it.** 

### a / relationship

The whole Bible is ultimately about Jesusii. Therefore, Christianity is fundamentally not centred around a bunch of precepts, but around a personiv. Here at City Gates we don't define our faith in terms of performing religious duties, but rather as having a life-giving relationship with Jesus Christ through the Holy Spirit.

### the / gospel

This tool may seem like it's full of things that you should do *for God*, but the Gospel is in fact the story of what God has done *for you* in and through His Son, Jesus<sup>v</sup>. Therefore, our efforts are not an attempt to *earn* God's love<sup>vi</sup>, but to *enjoy* it!

As we move into these next sections, remember that each step you take to adopt or deepen our values can be a step that brings you even closer to Jesus!

### 1 / Holy Spirit vii

The Holy Spirit is our connection with the *presence* and the *power* of Jesus. Therefore we live in sincere dependency on Him. He comes alongside us as our Helper, giving diverse gifts to Christians so that they may serve and build up the church and society. Aware of these God-given Spiritual Gifts, we actively seek opportunities in which to exercise them.

### 2 / serving viii

We gladly give up our rights and resources, and actively demonstrate sacrificial love by serving others in Jesus' name. We are not customers who consume religious goods or chase comfortable experiences, but servants who contribute to meet the needs of others.

### 3 / hospitality ix

According to Jesus everyone is our neighbour<sup>x</sup>, especially strangers, and even our enemies! We therefore place a high value on building relationships, pursuing friendship over friendliness; showing no favouritism. We move from greeting to eating, sharing our faith as we share our food.

### 4 / family xi

The church is not like a family, it is a family. We are a tight-knit community of brothers and sisters who share God as our Father. We don't merely get along, but seek to love each other just as Christ loved us. We don't gossip. We honour each other. We are quick to forgive, and even quicker to ask for forgiveness.

### 5/mission xii

We endeavour to use timely methods to best engage with society around this timeless truth.




### our / example
